Gift Aid Scheme –

A great many of us are tax payers and are therefore able to help increase the Church's income quite substantially through our committed giving. Through the Gift Aid Scheme, 25% can be reclaimed on the money you give. For example:

If you give £10.00 per week, that amounts to £520.00 per year. Add to that the extra £0.25 in every £1.00 (£130.00), and your gift becomes £650.00, at no additional cost to you.

Please read the following points:

- You must be paying Income Tax at least equal to the amount reclaimed by the Gift Aid Scheme.
- You must sign a Gift Aid Declaration, which remains in force until you cancel it – which you can do at any time by writing to the Parish's Gift Aid Officer.
- All donations must be recorded by the Church, to prove that the money has been received, to support the claim for the return of the tax – but only the Gift Aid Officer will know how much you are giving.
- Payment into the Gift Aid scheme can be made by Standing Order or by weekly numbered envelopes – the choice is yours.
- If you pay tax at a higher rate (40%), your gift will be eligible for a tax rebate at the current standard rate – and you will be credited with the difference.
