### Preferred method of Giving:

Through Standing Order Instruction (SOI) to my Bank (overleaf, but does not need completing if you do not wish to change any current SOI)

Through Planned Giving numbered envelopes supplied by the Church (these are available at the back of church)

A great many of us are tax-payers - and are therefore able to help increase the Church's income quite substantially through our committed giving. Through the Gift Aid Scheme, 25% can be reclaimed on the money you give, for example:

***If you give £50 per month that amounts to £600 per year. Add to that the extra 25p in every pound (£150), and your gift becomes £750 – at no additional cost to you...!!***

- You must be paying Income Tax at least equal to the amount reclaimed by the Gift Aid Scheme (£150 in the example above).
- You must sign a Gift Aid Declaration (overleaf), only if one has not been completed already, which remains in force until you cancel it – which you can do at any time by writing to the Parish's Gift Aid Officer (currently Paul Russell).
- All donations are recorded, to prove that the money has been received, to support the claim for the return of the tax – but only the Gift Aid Officer will know how much you are giving.
- Payment into the Gift Aid scheme can be made by Standing Order, ideally, or by weekly numbered envelopes – the choice is yours.
- If you pay tax at a higher rate (40%), your gift will be eligible for a tax rebate at the current standard rate – and you will be credited with the difference through submission of your annual Tax Return.
